SHELLEY What are you doing?

DOUG

Drumroll.

She stares at him. Shelley puts the key in the lock and turns it. The door slowly opens, creaking, almost on it's own.

DOUG Huh. Must be windy.

SHELLEY

Is it?

Doug attempts to pick her up, but is failing.

SHELLEY What are you doing?

DOUG Carrying you...over...the threshold.

SHELLEY We're not married yet. You don't have to-

DOUG Come on, you weigh like 90 pounds.

He continues to struggle, despite the fact that Shelley is rather petite. He eventually half-drags her through the door. He puts her down as the camera follows them in.

> DOUG There ya go. SHELLEY Thank you. DOUG (To camera.) So, here we are. Home sweet home-

Immediately, an overhead fan crashes to the floor directly behind them in the foyer from the second floor ceiling. They both react, startled. SHELLEY Oh my god, are you okay?! DOUG Yes, of course! SHELLEY Well can you take your claws out of me? He lets go of her, looking up at where the fan fell from. DOUG So...we didn't like that fan anyway, right? SHELLEY Less work for us.

They high five.

DOUG (To camera.) Come on, let's take you on the grand tour. Here we have the staircase.

SHELLEY (Quoting Ghostbusters.) Hey, where do these stairs go?

DOUG

What?

SHELLEY They go up! Ghostbusters.

DOUG Oh, yeah! Duh. I was gonna say that.

SHELLEY

Well...

DOUG (To camera.) We're kind of nerds. A ping-pong ball starts bouncing down the stairs. Doug and Shelley both stare at it until it finally hits the ground and lands in Doug's hand. Beat. DOUG Was there a ping pong table upstairs? Shelley shakes her head "no". DOUG Huh. He puts it up to his eye. DOUG (To camera, mugging.) I seeee yooooou... SHELLEY Please don't put that thing near your eye. DOUG Right. SHELLEY You don't know where it's been. DOUG On with the tour! They walk into the kitchen, the camera operator follows. DOUG Here we have the bathroom. Just kidding, it's the kitchen. SHELLEY We plan on replacing the cabinets, putting in a country sink, and adding granite counter tops. DOUG And check out the view from the nook, it looks right onto the front yard. And we can wave to the neighbors across the street!

Doug and Shelley wave to the neighbors. The camera zooms in on an elderly couple standing on their front porch. They stare out, not waving back.
